


Funding for collaborative research projects to address global challenges and European industrial competitiveness



Doctoral Networks

Multi-beneficiaries Actions to set up doctoral programmes in and outside academia, including standard doctoral network, industrial doctorate, and joint doctorate.

Funding: about EUR 2.7 million per project for 4-5 years

Postdoctoral Fellowships

Mono-beneficiary to **establish postdoctoral training programme** through a research project and to develop skills for academia and beyond.

Funding: about EUR 6700/month for 2-3 years fellowship

Staff Exchanges

Short-term international and intersectoral exchanges of research and innovation staff to equip research and organisational capacity.

Funding: about 1.6 million per project for 4 years

7-12 years after PhD up to € 2 Mio for 5 years



Advanced Grants

track-record of significant research achievements in the last 10 years up to € 2.5 Mio for 5 years



Starting Grants

2-7 years after PhD up to € 1.5 Mio for 5 years



Synergy Grants

2 – 4 Principal Investigators
 up to € 10.0 Mio
 for 6 years
 1 PI can be based outside
 EU/Associated Countries

Research and Innovation Actions (RIA)

Projects that establish new knowledge or explore the feasibility of a new or improved technology, product, process, services

100%

Projects starting at TRL 2-3 and reaching TRL 5-6

Innovation Actions (IA)

Projects that produce plans or design for new or improved products, processes or services including prototyping, testing, demonstrating, piloting, large-scale product validation and market replication

100% for non-profits, 70 % for other participants

Projects starting at TRL 4-5 and reaching TRL 6-8

Typically, 3 years

Ranging from EUR 4 to 15 million



Partner Consortium: Capacity is Key

Operational Capacity and Financial Capacity

Minimum of 3 partner organizations required:

✓ Based in different EU or Associated Countries.

✓ At least one partner must be from an EU member state.

Once the minimum criteria are met, institutions from ASEAN are eligible to be part of such consortia.


